



The FLITe programme is a hands on Lean Practitioner course, delivered in a practical 'on site' environment.

Originally developed with Skanska to target improvement opportunities in the construction process, the FLITe programme is now widely used throughout the civils industry.

The course focuses on five key Lean improvement techniques, supporting practitioners to develop Lean thinking and become 'sighted' - able to see waste in all its forms.

The FLITe Programme is designed on the principle that building the skills and understanding necessary to deliver improvement on a site or project, is a process that requires both time and real world application. Candidates start by learning a few fundamental Lean principles and techniques, which they are able to practice in a live site/project environment. Over the duration of the course these are embedded and scaled up as candidates are supported to deliver improvement projects within their business.

Over the past four years, over 300 candidates have completed the course, generating millions of pounds in efficiencies and improvement. They've come from multiple disciplines and many organisations, contractors and subcontractors with over 95% scoring FLITe either excellent or good across a range of measures.

The course is supported by a full suite of e-learning material that can be downloaded via the Rubicon Wigzell website.
